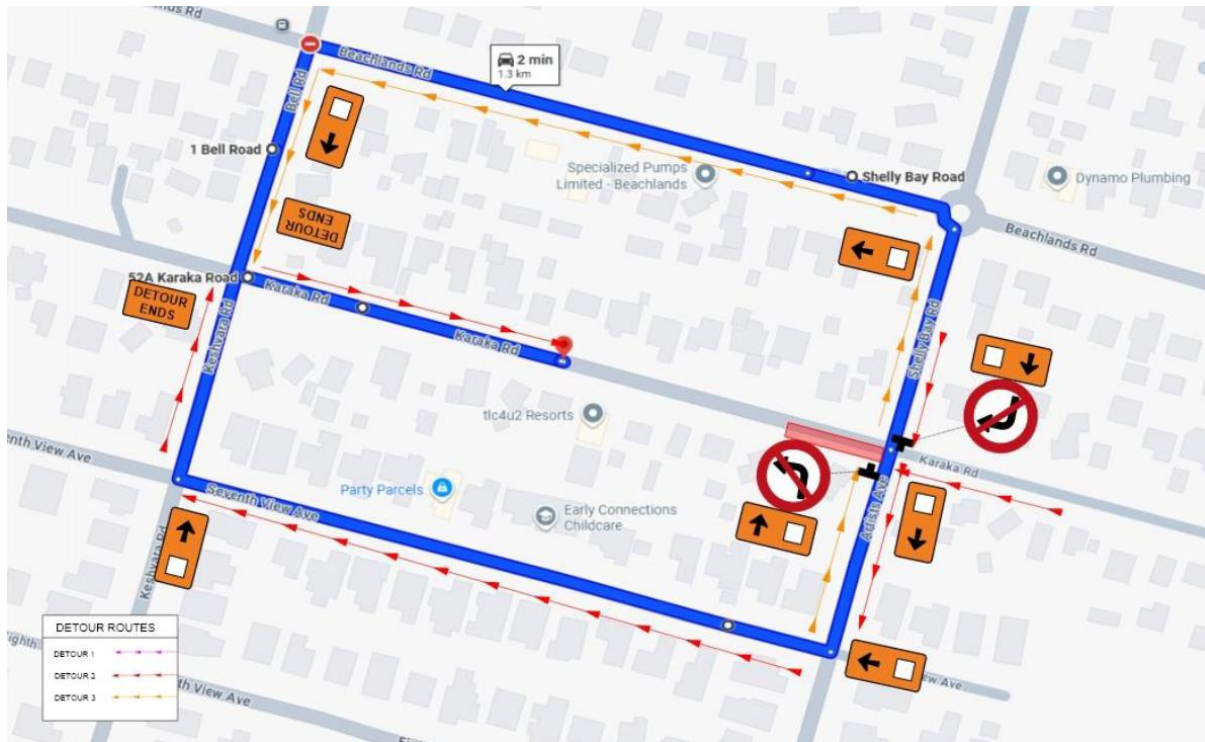

What we're doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Construction of a new footpath on the western side of Shelly Bay Road Installation of new pram crossings on the intersection of Karaka Road
How it may impact you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On-street parking will be limited during works. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property. Works will create noise and vibration; we'll do our best to keep noise levels down.
How travel is affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lanes on Shelly Bay Road will be reduced Detours will be in place to redirect traffic around the work site (see detour map(s) below). <p>Traffic controllers will be on site to assist around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.</p>

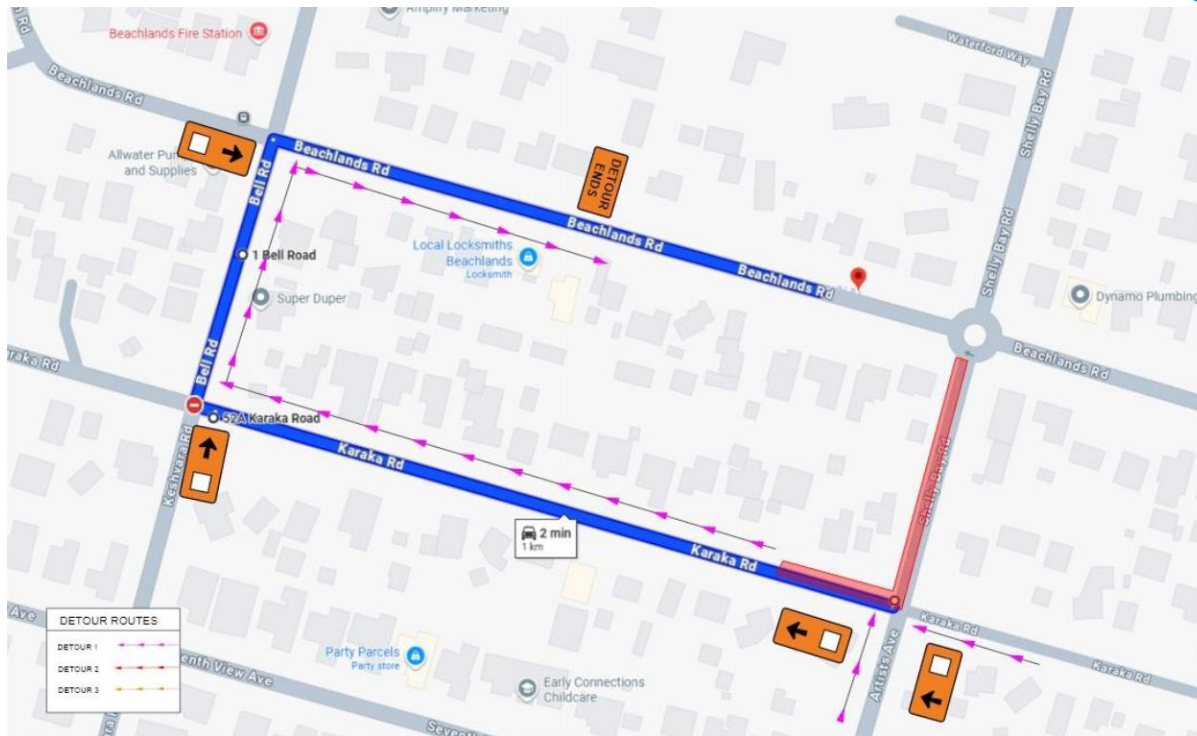
Work location
